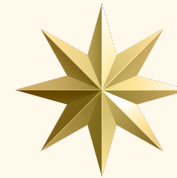
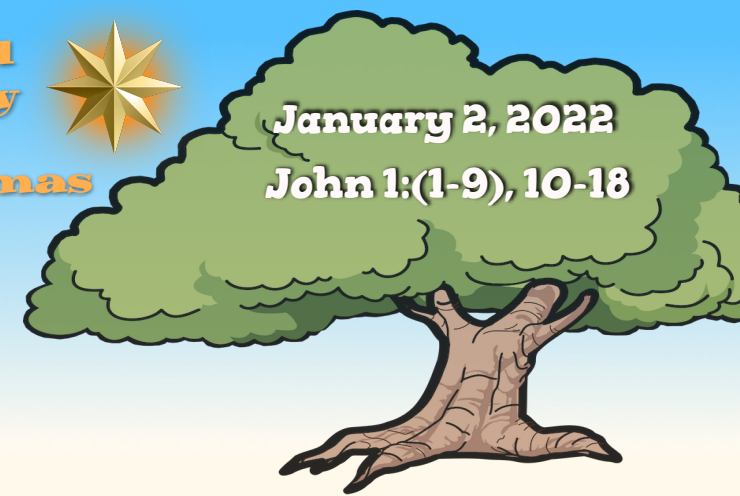

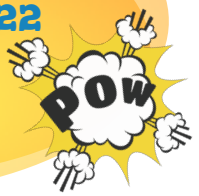

A great big, super-duper, gigantic word meaning how God became the "flesh" (became a human being) in Jesus!

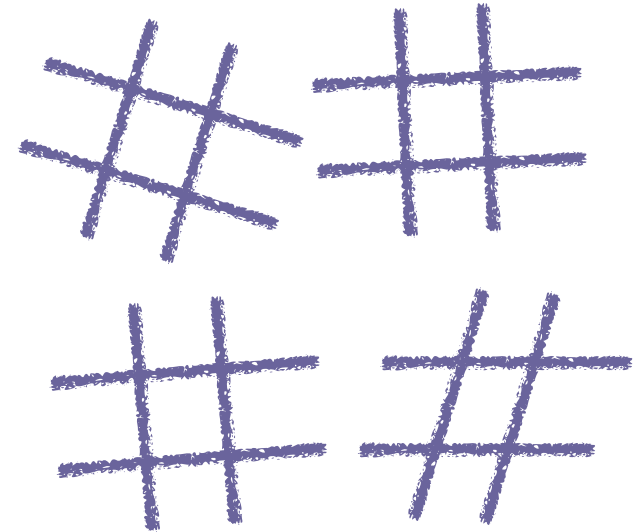
