

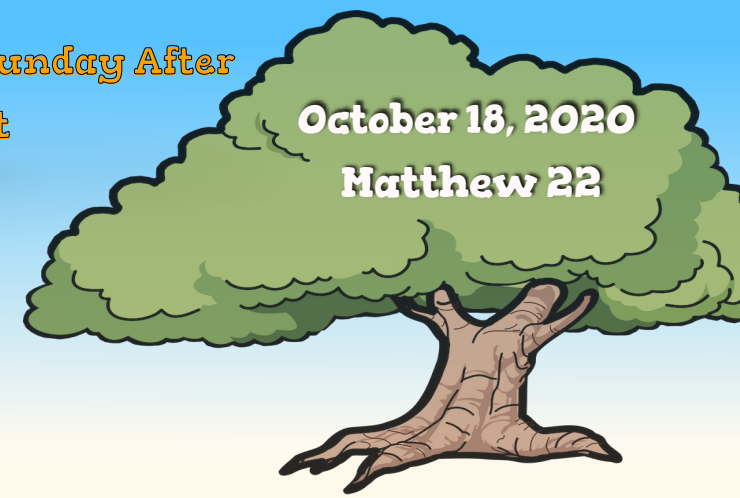


Some ancient cultures used paper money, just like we do today. Most of that happened in China though – they were way ahead as far as that goes.

Jesus nodded. "Exactly! So if you believe God is the ruler of the world, you need to take care of all the things that belong to God."

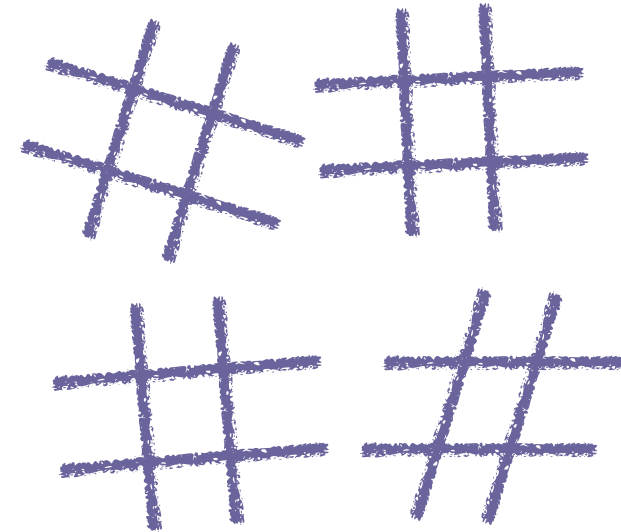
The leaders frowned. They had not tricked Jesus. Instead, Jesus had reminded them of the things they were doing wrong themselves! They didn't like this one bit.
