



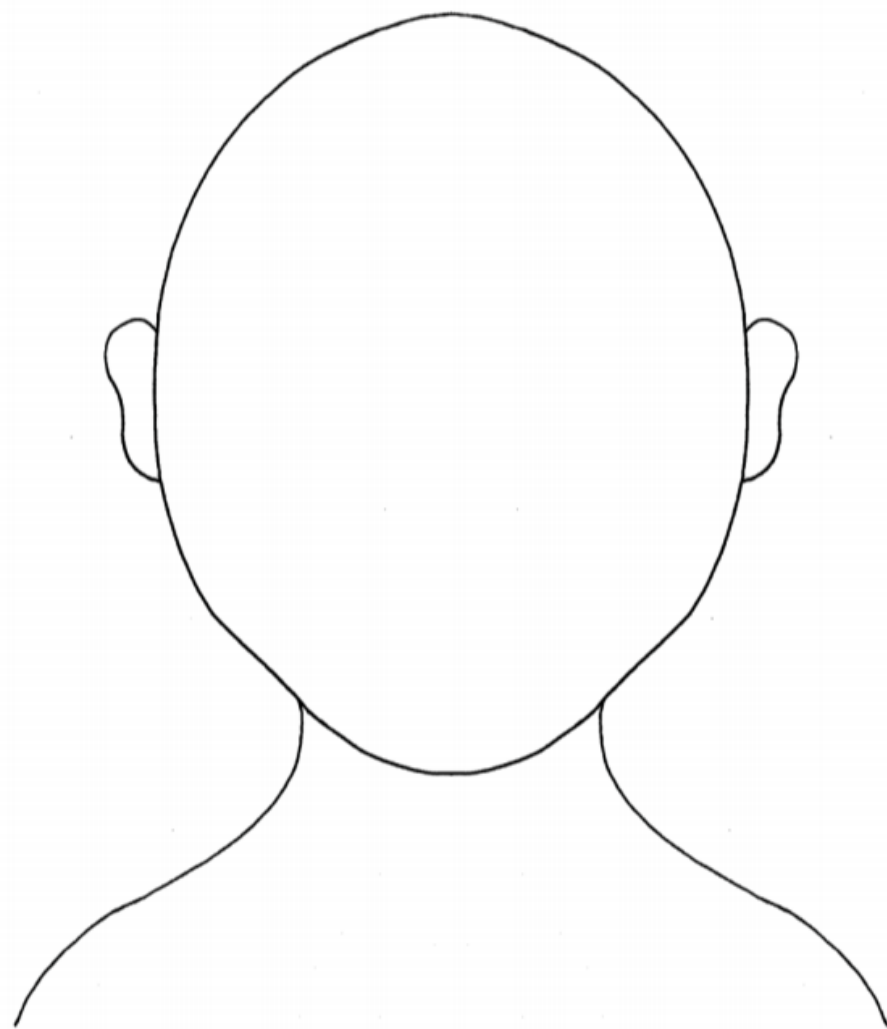
Did'ja Know?

The transfiguration was just one way that the disciples got to know that Jesus wasn't just special, but that he was the Son of God.

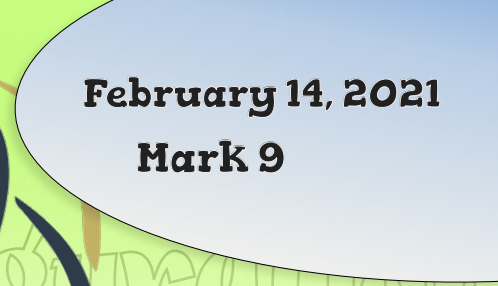

A big, fancy word for "change."

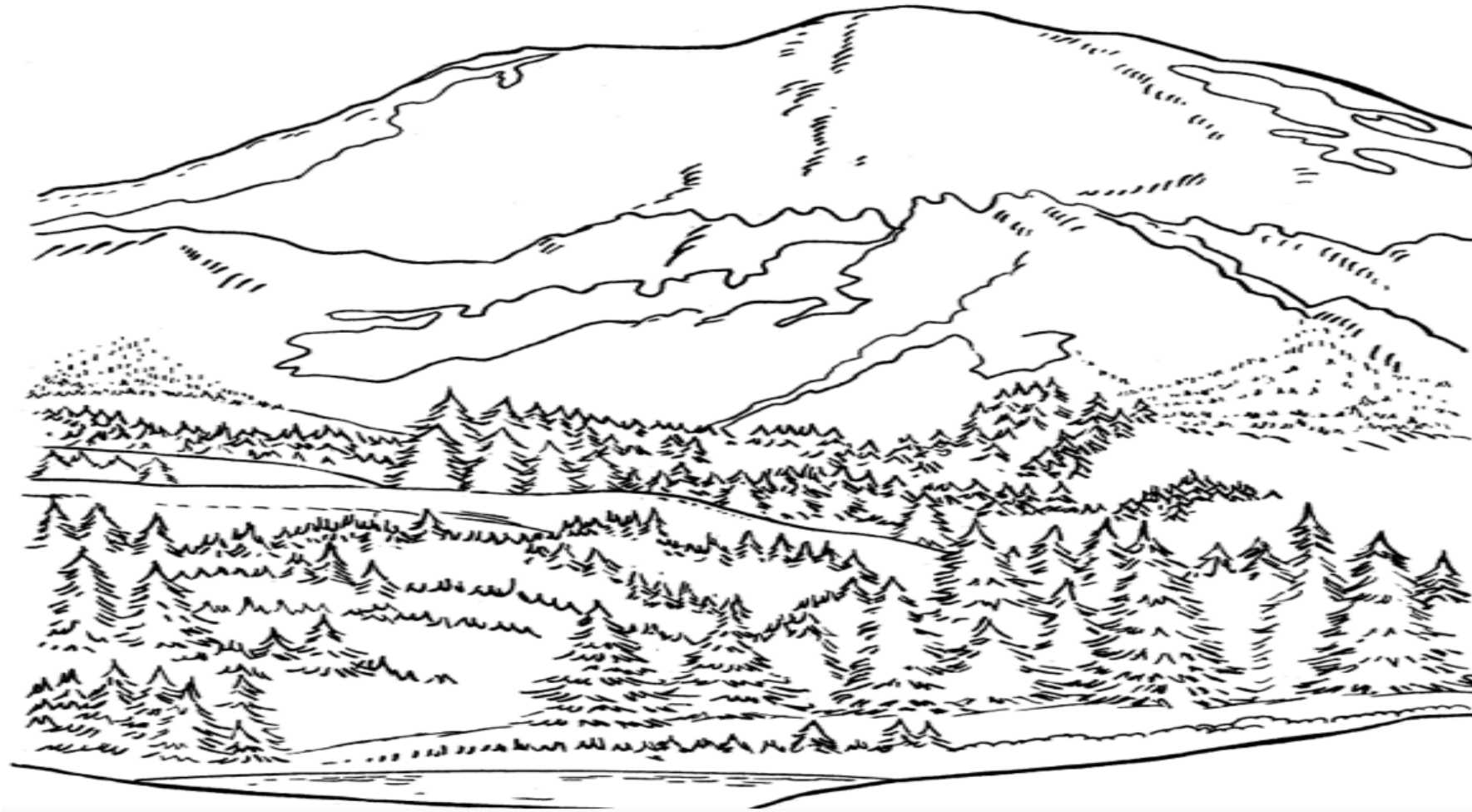

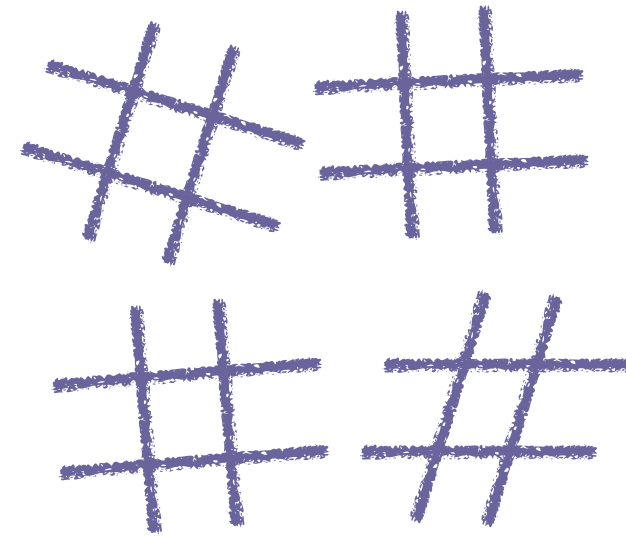
Mountains are fun because you can see so far! Color the mountain scene below and imagine what it would be like to visit there.
