Sometimes when Jesus taught the crowds, he spoke in parables. Parables are stories about things that are used to explain a situation in real life.

One parable was about a person who was planting seeds. Some of the seeds landed on good soil, and they grew into fruitful plants. But the seeds that landed on rocks were washed away. Some seeds fell in thorns, and they didn't grow over all the thick weeds.

Jesus explained that the seed was the word of God. The different places the seeds landed were different people and how they heard God's word. When God's word moves us, we are like the seeds that landed on good soil.

We can grow and be fruitful, too!


