The Mustard Seed

Jesus taught the people about God's reign by telling stories about things they would understand. These stories were called parables.

In one parable, Jesus said, "God's reign is like a teeny, tiny, little mustard seed. It's so small you can barely see it. But when you plant it, it grows into huge plants, so big that birds can make nests in it!"

What Jesus meant was that even the tiniest bit of God's love, when we plant it in the ground of our hearts and our communities, will grow and grow and grow until it's bigger than we can imagine!

We can all plant little seeds of God's love everywhere we go and in everyone we meet, and just that little bit can make a huge difference in the world. How cool is that?
