It's the Day of Pentecost and the Holy Spirit has given the gift of spreading the Good News!

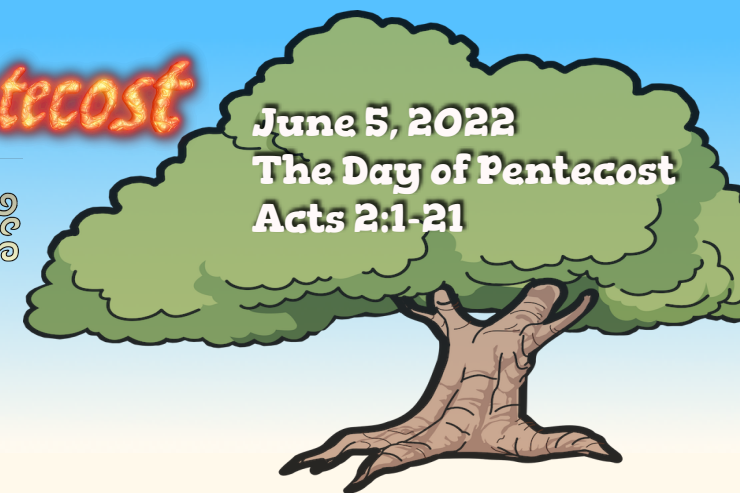

The part of God that inspires and drives us forward to do God's work.

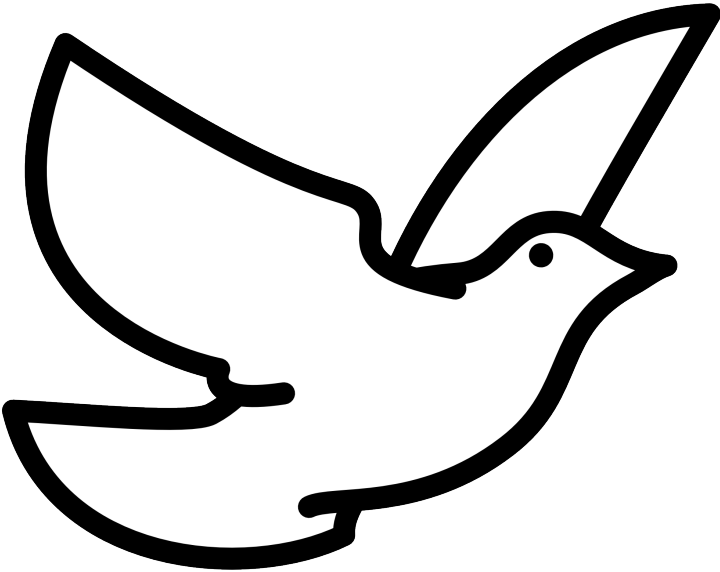

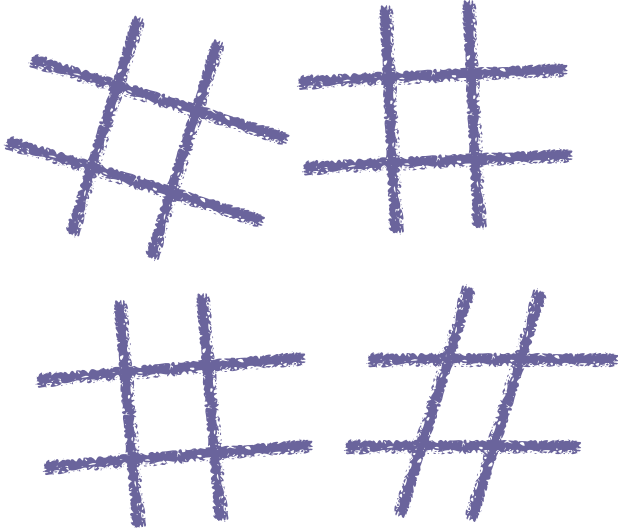
