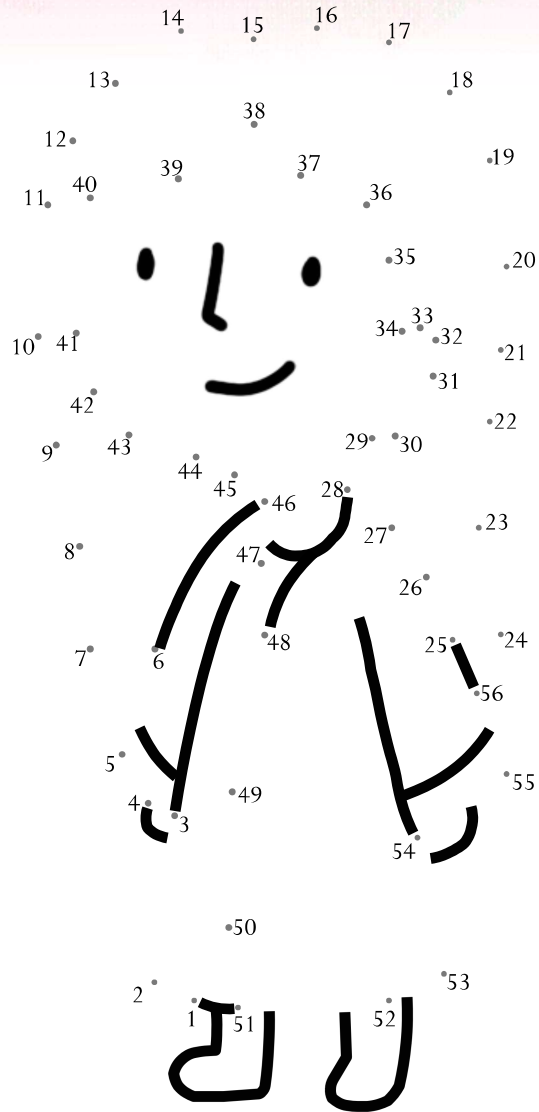


Draw & Color

"Okay, Jesus," said Phillip. "We can do that."



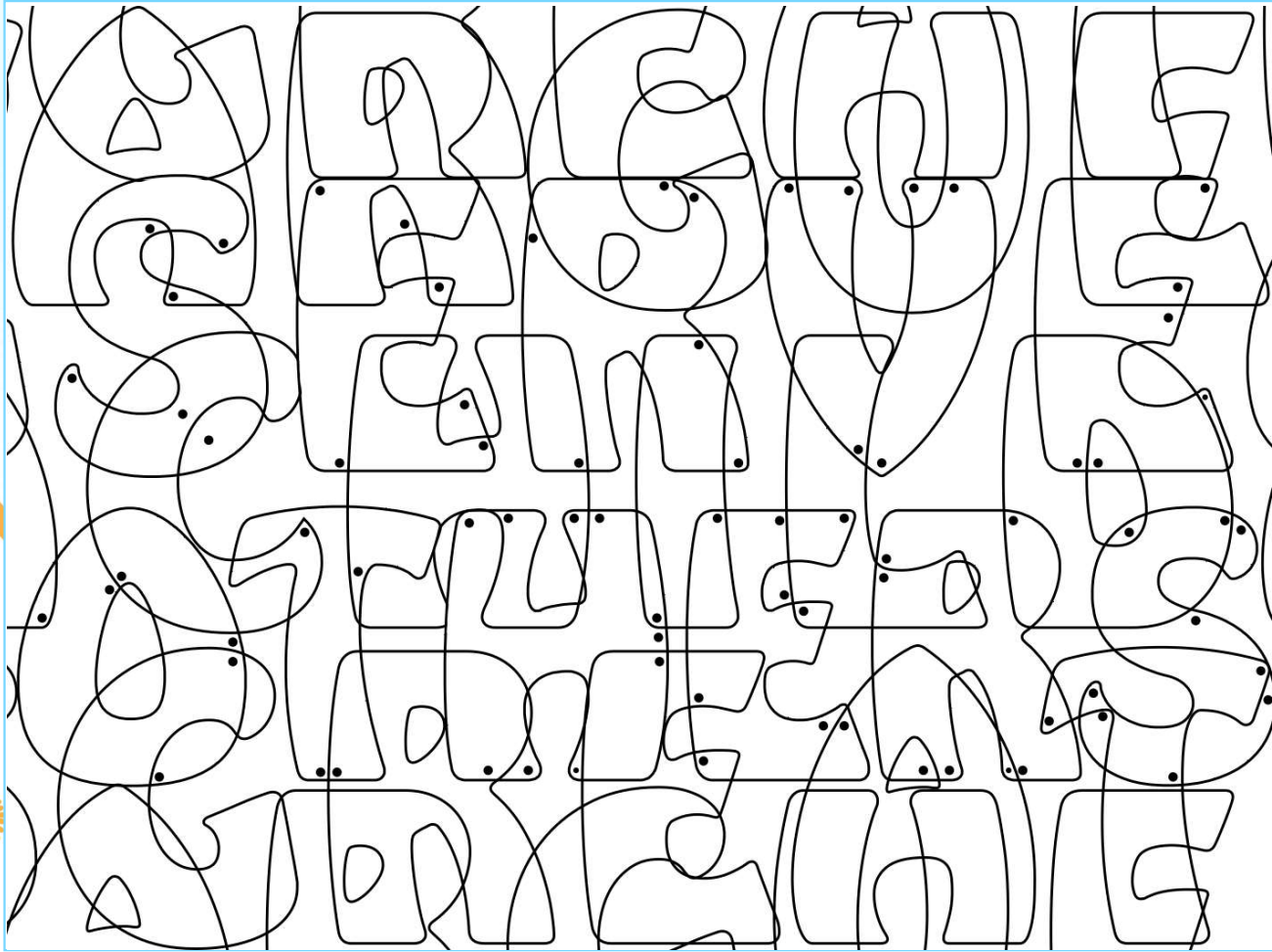
REMEMBER THIS
