SERVICE & JUSTICE (S&J) SURVEY RESULTS (Kate Everett)

- The purpose of the S&J survey was to dig deeper into why/how we are giving, and make sure we are aligned with the congregation and being good stewards
- Results were gathered over six weeks. We received 115 responses in either paper or digital form.
- The survey results will be shared with the congregation in September's Service & Justice newsletter, and also in other settings such as a future Temple Talk.
- The S&J committee would like to collaborate with Stewardship to raise up how giving helps fund these initiatives.
- Ths slideset was shared with the Council prior to the meeting and contains additional details.

CALL COMMITTEE UPDATES (Kim W)

- The call committee has been meeting and preparing to interview Pastor Dan for the Senior Pastor position. Updates have been shared in the service and posted to the church website on the https://www.immanuel.us/about/transition page.
- The council discussed ideas for improving the process, which Kim will bring back to the call committee.

ATTENDANCE AND FINANCIAL UPDATES

Giving - Rick I.

- June giving exceeded the budget by \$10K
- Year-to-date, we are \$72K ahead, but looking at a 12-month rolling period, we are \$26K lower, so Rick will investigate this in more detail.
- Pastor Steve and Kelly M have been good resources.
- Rick is planning communications to the congregation on giving ideas, like Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) donations.

Attendance - Rick I.

- Attendance through June was about 16,400, including in-person and online attendees. This is the highest for Immanuel since 2021.
- Looking at a 12-month rolling period, attendance has gone up for four consecutive years.
- See attached for more details on giving and attendance.

Financial Statements - Kirsten S.

- As of July, Immanuel's overall income and expenses are looking good compared to the budget.
- The budget allocation is based on 36 months of historical data.
- Personnel is under budget due to staffing changes.
- Building expenses are over budget due to necessary roof repairs.
- Benevolence is over budget due to income being high and benevolence amounts being determined by taking a percentage of income.
- Youth Ministry is under budget due to the delayed payment of High School and Middle School trip expenses.
- A team is working on documentation on how to make Memorials spending requests. We have Memorial fund money saved up that needs to be spent. About half of Memorial funds have restrictions on them, and half do not. For now, contact Jennifer Urbanski, Kelly Meyers, and Rick Ites with requests.
- The Youth Fundraising account has also grown too large. Jolene E. is going through and working on changes.
- Youth Scholarships account Paul E. and Grace P. are working on policies for spending this.

Building Contingency Fund - Kirsten S and Lou H.

- This is a new fund that we added, so we have money set aside to maintain the building.
- We have a list of what needs to be fixed, and we are getting estimates.
- This is a different type of capital campaign, so we can just keep up with needs.
- The Stewardship campaign this year should address building-related needs.
- Budgeting will also be impacted.

VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT - Tom G.

- In September, Tom G. will email committees their job descriptions. Each committee should make corrections to its job description if needed, and also provide a detailed list of volunteer opportunities and time commitments.
- In October, we are planning to have an Immanuel "Volunteer Career Fair".
- In November, the synod volunteer workshop will be hosted at Immanuel.
- In December, Tom will engage with the nominating committee. It was noted that the nominating committee will start its work sooner than that. The goal is to have a full slate of nominees for next year's council positions by December/January.

Pastor Dan

- No funerals or baptisms.
- The office has been quiet.
- Grace just returned from the Middle School Duluth service learning trip.
- The staff is working on signups for fall ministries and announcements related to the Tent Meeting weekend.
- Pastor Steve has been a valuable presence and offers insightful perspectives.
- Pastor Dan has a book recommendation for church council members. It is based on the Church in the Secular Age book series, distilled into a short book written for councils called <u>When</u> <u>Church Stops Working</u>. It discusses topics including shifts in what drives the vitality of congregations. It could help us to identify central vs. peripheral topics. Andy Root and Blaire Bertrand.

Deacon Savannah

- Worshipping with partner ministries has been special, and Savannah will keep doing this throughout the year, the first Sunday of every month. Church members are encouraged to join her.
- The artwork of a feather on the wall outside the sanctuary is a gift from All Nations Indian Church.
