Giving in April was a little under budget but over last year. We are projecting to be holding steady through May and June. Our giving exceeds our expenses. We think that May/June will show the true impact of giving due to Covid-19. Electronic giving is up. We are receiving offerings from places that are not close to Eden Prairie.

Attendance is misleading electronically- it is counted by household and not individual. 6300 views on facebook = ~11,000 in attendance.

Staff Updates:

Pastor Paul:

We are looking to hire an audio/soundperson during the livestreaming on Sundays. 3 hours for each shift \$20/hr pay rate. Clark needs to be in front vs behind the scenes with Gary retiring. It would be \$3200 per year.

Motion to hire an audio/soundperson for Sundays- 1st Jessica, 2nd Jerry- Motion passed

We've had 2 funerals via livestream, 1 graveside and 1 wedding in a backyard.

Introducing outside Wednesday night campfires from 7-7:45 with a limited signup. We will hold devotions and campfire. Possible first date is July 1st.

We are in the process of assembling a new protocols/practices committee for re-opening the church. Volunteers are needed.

2nd round of phone calls are happening. Reaching out to congregation members for any needs they have (physical, spiritual or emotional)

Roof repairs: We have 3 leaks that need to be repaired. Tom Totall will be giving us an additional estimate. Sections 1, 3 and 5 need to be replaced. We do have the funds to cover the replacements due to generous giving. We are looking at \$80,000-100,000 in cost.
