**Pray:** Light a candle. Open your devotion with prayer.

**Read:** Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

<sup>31</sup>He said to him, "If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead." (Luke 16:31)



**Reflect:** Reflect on the scripture summary.

Nothing external could change the hearts and minds of the rich man or his brothers as they selfishly ignored the needs of those around them. Change comes from within.



**Connect:** Connect in conversation with others in your household or community.

What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?

Do you spend more time and energy reconciling for the past, planning for the future, or living for today? Why?

For the littles: Who do you trust the most? Why?



**Bless:** Close your devotion with a blessing.

May God open your ears and your hearts to God's truth. Amen.



**Do:** By acting on what we learn, we make God's word come alive. Do the following activity this week.
